



IJCRS2016 Special Memorial Session for Professor Zdzislaw Pawlak

The 2016 International Joint Conference on Rough Sets will be held in Santiago, Chile, October 7-11, 2016. It is the 1st time to have an international rough set conference in the South America. Professor Zdzislaw Pawlak, the father of rough set theory, passed away in 2006. The International Rough Set Society (IRSS) is going to have a special memorial session for him to respect his great contribution to the development of worldwide sciences and technologies. All his friends and rough set researchers are invited to join the special memorial session.

There are two ways to have a presentation at this special memorial session, that is,

1. Submit a memorial paper to this session online at the IJCRS paper submission system (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=ijcrs2016>).

The program committee will review the submission and make a decision. A submission will be accepted into the IJCRS2016 proceedings if it passes the review successfully. Thus, the authors will be invited to present their paper at the special session. Otherwise, the authors will be invited to have a presentation without publishing a paper in the proceedings if the committee thinks it suitable for a presentation at this session.

2. Submit an extended abstract of your memorial presentation online at the IJCRS paper submission system. The authors will be invited to have a presentation without publishing a paper in the proceedings if the committee thinks it suitable for a presentation at this session.

The deadline for an extended abstract submission to this special memorial session is July 25, 2016.
